- I. Meeting called to order by Jim Young at 5:32 pm. Amy Johnston was welcomed and introduced herself as a new Board member. Other Board members introduced themselves to her.

  A. Fund Balances include US Bank Checking Account: \$38,853.71, US Bank Money Market
  Account--closed out and temporarily moved to checking: \$00.00, CFNEIA Endowment Fund:
  \$1,265,083.18. There were several nice year-end donations, including a \$1,000 Robert Denny
  grant. The Winter Woodland refreshment expenses totaled roughly \$340.00. The \$20,000
  Gallagher Family donation was sent on to Hartman Reserve per their request.

# **Up-coming programs:**

- Iowa Games Snowshoe Race 1/7/23: 15 people attended
- Yoga dancing1/8/23

- Partnering with Zoo in Omaha where they are working to re-establish endangered amphibians like Hartman's blue salamander. Hartman needs to search for and find more larvae for the zoo to raise. Zoo is considering if they want to continue the project; Hartman needs to work to assure the project can continue.

### **Project Updates:**

 Motus supplies are coming in! A motus tower (like a TV antenna) which will track tagged birds to inventory types of birds come through Hartman and also track migration.

# **Friends Funding for 2023**

- Maple Syrup Fest: \$500—needed soon
- Under The Harvest Moon: \$500—next fiscal year
- Woodland Wonderland: Cookies, Cocoa, and Volunteering, roughly \$400—next fiscal year
- Memory Café: \$360 for programs—\$200 next fiscal year (\$160 in this fiscal year)
- School Field Trips \$12,000 –July 2023
- Research intern 300 hours x\$14.00 per hour = \$4,200: from Upper lowa to work on the salamander project this year—needed now
- Senior programs, 4 field trips a month \$2,000: Up to four programs per month at no cost—needed now
- 20 pair of binoculars \$2,400—needed now
- Spotting scope \$2,000—now would be nice
